


## How to provide carcass location information




» Use Grid Reference Finder (method can be used on smart phone, online ONLY):

- [www.gridreferencefinder.com/](http://www.gridreferencefinder.com/)
- Allows you to enter Post Code, Road or Town to provide you a grid reference of your location

» Use what3words (method can be used on smart phone, online and offline):

	
<p>what3words can be downloaded for free onto any smart phone. It provides every 3m<sup>3</sup> in the world with three words.</p>	
<p>When online and offline, the app will detect your location. This is indicated by the blue dot.</p>	
<p>When offline it may take time to settle on your location. To be certain, when online and offline, press this icon to provide your location.</p>	
<p>The search bar will then provide the 3words.</p>	

» Use Google maps (method can be used on any smart phone, online and offline):

	
<p>Google Maps can be downloaded for free onto any smart phone.</p>	
<p>When online and offline, the app will detect your location. This is indicated by the blue dot. Press and hold the blue dot on the map.</p>	
<p>A red pin will appear. Press and hold on Red Pin.</p>	
<p>This will bring up a blue pin on a drop down menu, which will provide the Latitude and Longitude for the carcass location.</p>
