Licensed Finishing Unit (LFU) in England

Housed LFUs provide an outlet for the finishing of negative testing cattle from multiple officially TB free (OTF) herds

General Conditions

- Only approved in the Low Risk Area (LRA) of England
- Can source cattle from any area of England, Scotland and Wales
- Robust biosecurity requirements must be in place, including wildlife proofing of buildings

Testing & Movements

- Cattle sourced from annual (or more frequent) testing herds must have completed a pre-movement test with a negative result within 60 days before moving to an LFU
- Cattle in the unit are exempt from post-movement testing, providing the statutory pre-movement testing requirements have been met.
- Cattle in an LFU are also exempt from routine surveillance testing
- Cattle finished in an LFU are under permanent movement restrictions and can only move to slaughter, either directly or via a TB approved slaughter gathering (red market)
