STAGE 1
Hotspot launch

- Introduce enhanced TB surveillance (increased frequency testing, six-monthly or annual testing)

STAGE 2
Review

- Comprehensive review of evidence available
- Reduce/increase controls as required
- Start found dead wildlife surveillance (PMEs) *if needed*

STAGE 3
Wildlife involved

- Continue to review evidence available
- Matching WGS identified in local wildlife
- Start wildlife *activity* surveillance to inform wildlife controls

STAGE 4
Wildlife control

- Continue to review evidence available
- Review results from wildlife controls to decide next steps

STAGE 5
Hotspot closure

- Continue to review evidence available
- Reduce cattle controls as required- breakdowns herds clear of TB & frequency of testing goes back to normal
- Ensure effective completion of wildlife controls
